At Her Command

The idea for Marcia James' light-hearted romantic suspense, *At Her Command*, came from her time living in Washington, D.C. "The thing I noticed is that there are all these different law-enforcement agencies, but they don't work together," she says. So she decided to bring operatives from all the agencies together to investigate a crime that has taken place at an exclusive sex club with powerful members, including senators and Supreme Court justices.

The thing is, all the operatives are working undercover, and since their agencies don't communicate, they don't know that some of the people they're investigating are also covert agents.

It's the perfect set-up for a modern-day farce. The story focuses on the relationship between a macho cop working undercover as a submissive and a sexy DEA agent working undercover as a Dom. "I like my heroes and heroines to be equals," says Marcia, who describes herself as a rabid feminist. "They're both powerful people who have to compromise to be together."

Perhaps the most unusual character in the book is Smokey, a drug-sniffing Chinese Crested Hairless dog that everyone tends to underestimate because he's so little and weird looking. If you don't know what a Chinese Crested looks like, check out Marcia's website, where you'll also find a funny sex-oriented question-and-answer column by Alley Sky, the heroine of Marcia's work-in-progress about the adventures of a woman who's a professional sex therapist and an amateur sleuth.
